SERIOUSLY CONSIDER THIS BIBLE STORY AND DECIDE FOR YOURSELF!

The Book of 2 Kings Chapter 4:

1 Now there cried a certain woman of the wives of the sons of the prophets unto Elisha, saying, Thy servant my husband is dead; and thou knowest that thy servant did fear the LORD: and the creditor is come to take unto him my two sons to be bondmen.

2 And Elisha said unto her, What shall I do for thee? tell me, what hast thou in the house? And she said, Thine handmaid hath not any thing in the house, save a pot of oil.

3 Then he said, Go, borrow thee vessels abroad of all thy neighbors, even empty vessels; borrow not a few.

4 And when thou art come in, thou shalt shut the door upon thee and upon thy sons, and shalt pour out into all those vessels, and thou shalt set aside that which is full.

5 So she went from him, and shut the door upon her and upon her sons, who brought the vessels to her; and she poured out.

6 And it came to pass, when the vessels were full, that she said unto her son, Bring me yet a vessel. And he said unto her, There is not a vessel more. And the oil stayed.

*7 Then she came and told the man of God. And he said, **Go, SELL the oil, and PAY thy DEBT, and LIVE thou and thy children of the rest.***

10 Steps To Successfully Opening Your First Blog With Blogger.com

1. Open a Google mail account at <http://google.com>
2. Sign in to your account at Google.com; Top Right is SIGN IN area.
3. Use Your g-Mail account to open your Blogger.com account
4. Enter into account area and note "My Products" area; Go down to BLOGGER; Click; Go to Blogger; <http://blogger.com>
5. Begin by editing your Profile-Top Right.
6. Look for "Manage Your Blogs;" Go to the right to "CREATE A BLOG!"
7. CLICK "Create A Blog!"; complete step 1
8. Name your blog; make a url for your blog; try different simple names for availability; complete step 2
9. Pick a template you would like to use for your blog; complete step 3
10. Start blogging! "Post A Blog!"
